

The New York State Police will host the annual "NYSP Crimes Against Children Seminar" during the week of March 28th – April 1st, 2022, for law enforcement, social service agencies, prosecutors, and victim advocates who work in New York State. This year the seminar will be held at the New York State Police Academy, Albany NY. This Seminar is intended to assist field level personnel in the successful investigation of offenses committed against children. This extensive training is provided at no cost to attendees.

Topics to be presented include: a survivor's presentation; the medical evaluation of child victims; neurobiology and trauma informed investigations; forensic odontology; cultural and developmental issues and how they impact investigations; child exploitation case review; I.C.A.C. Taskforce; 2020 legislation, children with problematic sexual behaviors, and more.
